Dr. Preeya Mohan is a Senior Fellow at the Sir Arthur Lewis Institute of Social and Economic Studies, University of the West Indies, St. Augustine. As a graduate of the SALISES, St Augustine with a PhD in Economic Development Policy (high commendation), she is an applied economist skilled in the use of sophisticated econometric methods, and in data analysis more generally. She has conducted research on and is widely published on a range of topics focused on Caribbean growth and development, including climate change and natural disasters, diversification, public finance, innovation and entrepreneurship. Food Policy, Entrepreneurship and Regional Development, Tourism Economics, Ecological Economics, The World Economy, and Energy Policy are some of the international peer-reviewed journals Dr. Mohan has published in.

As a recipient of several research grants and awards, Dr Mohan has worked on various research projects funded by international bodies including the Inter-American Development Bank, the International Development Research Centre and the Social Sciences Humanities Research Council of Canada. She serves as co-editor to the Island Studies Journal, an international interdisciplinary journal established by the University of Prince Edward Island's Institute of Island Studies. Dr. Mohan teaches and supervises graduate students in a diverse range of development topics and quantitative research methodologies and feels that it is part of her responsibility to give back to students what she has been taught. She has presented and participated in several policy debates regionally and internationally and sees it as paramount to the Caribbean growth and development process to make public reasoned arguments that are supported by research and academic expertise.
